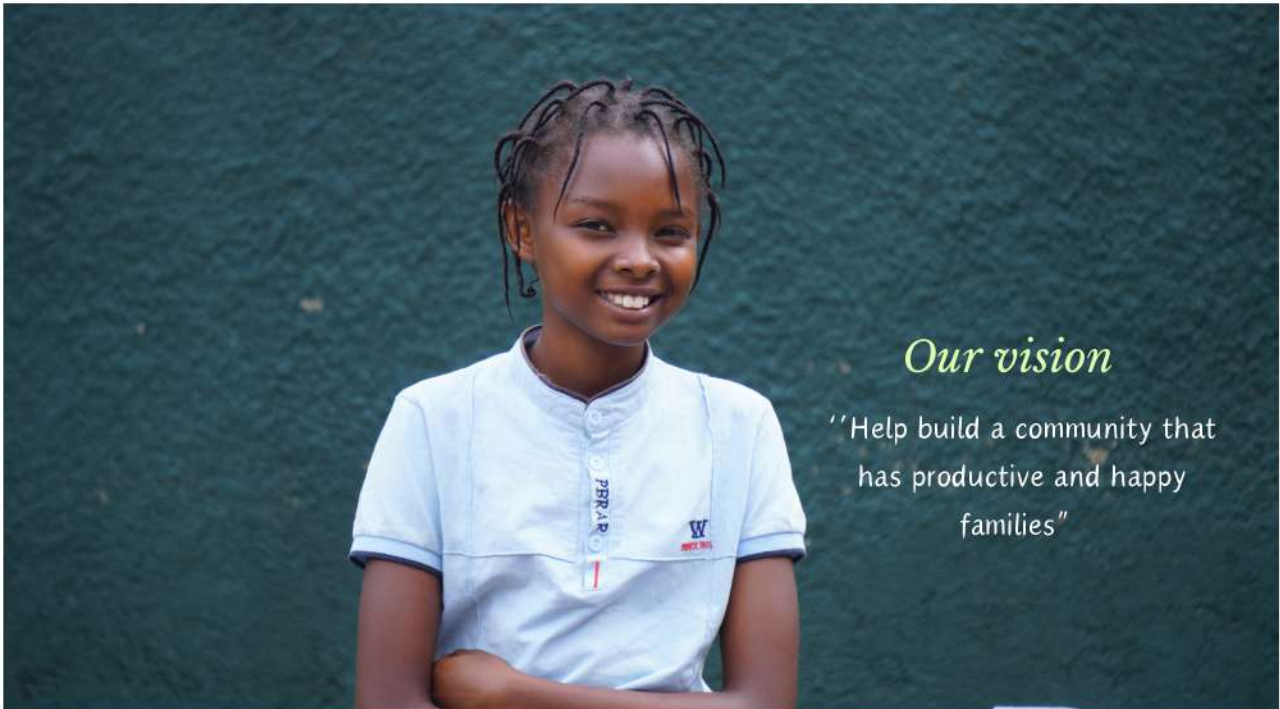

☒ EDUCATIONAL SPONSORSHIP

Education plays a crucial role in assisting children and their families to escape the cycle of poverty. The core of Baho Community's developmental initiatives lies in educational sponsorship. With the help of Baho Outreach and Hope Milele Africa, more than 189 students in Rwanda receive sponsorship. This support allows them to attend school consistently and provides the necessary study materials and assistance. By sponsoring a child, we create a solid foundation that helps eliminate the poverty cycle.

The Baho Community aims to expand its key program, which is the health and well-being of children. We guarantee that all sponsored children and their families can access medical services and receive health insurance.

OUR ACHIEVEMENTS

EDUCATIONAL SPONSORSHIP

The Baho Community has established a robust collaborative relationship with Baho Outreach Inc. and Hope Milele Africa Inc. from the USA. With the support of these two organizations, a total of 189 students have been able to receive quality education. The Baho Community has extended its support to children at various educational stages: nursery (12), primary (96), junior and high school (68), and university (13).

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Starting in 2024, 189 children from 163 families had access to medical insurance coverage.

A total of 904 people from 163 families were impacted. Most of these family members participated in Self-Help Groups and underwent project management, savings, and sustainability training.

FAITH AND DEVELOPMENT

Baho Community partners with local churches to impart the teachings of the Bible to every child involved in our sponsorship program. Our organization focuses on holistic development. We support children's education and are dedicated to nurturing their spiritual growth.

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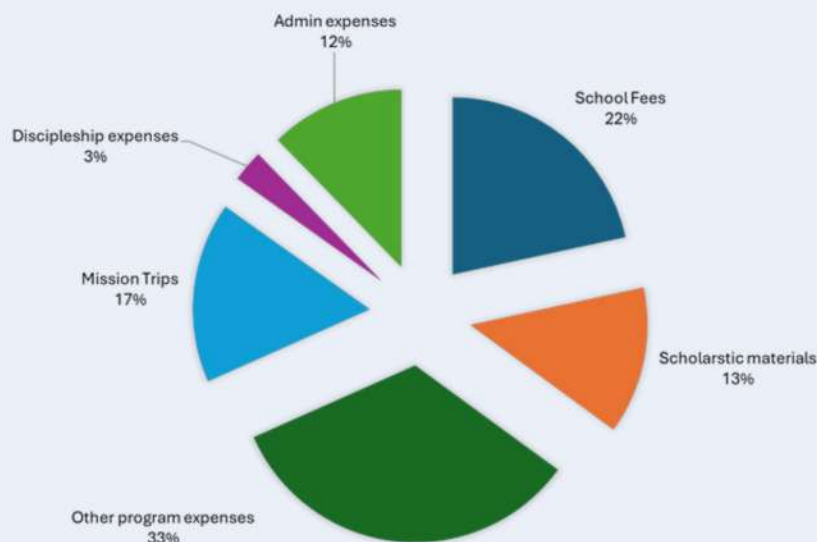

SUMMARY

This general expense summary covers six major program areas:

- **Administration costs** account for 12% of total expenses. This category encompasses general office expenses, water bills, internet charges, staff salaries and transport.
- **School fees** account for 22% of the overall expenses. This expense covers school fees for all children in the program in their respective levels.
- **Discipleship expenses:** This section takes 3% of the total program expenses. It includes church rent, bible clubs and other discipleship related expenses.
- **Scholarstic materials:** This category pertains to the school materials provided to students. It represents a significant cost, accounting for 13% of the overall program expenditures. Students from various groups have distinct educational requirements, including clothing, textbooks, and additional resources.
- **Other program expenses** categorized under "Other" account for 33% and include significant items such as gifts, medical expenses, and school construction project.
- **Mission trip expenses:** We hosted teams from Oklahoma and California, with the total expenses amounting to 17% of the general program expenses.

CLOSING REMARKS

The Baho Community has developed a strong partnership with Baho Outreach Inc. and Hope Milele Africa to improve the lives of vulnerable children and their families in Rwanda. Since the beginning of 2024, our organization has seen considerable expansion. Baho Community has supported over 189 children, fulfilling all their educational needs. Medical help was provided to 904 individuals from 163 families.

In 2024, our community encountered numerous challenges, yet there were still some encouraging developments. Throughout the country, more than 9,000 churches, including Baho Outreach Church, closed their doors. The majority of individuals in the Baho Community were affiliated with Baho Outreach Church, making it quite hard for them to reach other places of worship now.

This year, we accomplished our greatest dream. Thanks to the support of Baho Outreach Inc. and its partners, the Baho Community has started building a school. While the construction is still ongoing, we have achieved significant milestones. We are optimistic about completing the school by June 2025.

On behalf of the Baho Community, I take this opportunity to thank God and everyone who supported our cause this year, 2024.
